Research Councils UK policy on open access



Applies to journal articles and conference proceedings

Concerns outputs accepted for publication after April 2013

Applies to outputs acknowledging RCUK funding

Gold or green OA route

CC-BY license for Gold

6 months embargo for STEM, 12 months for AHSS

Statement on how the underlying data can be accessed

Workflow for administering Article Processing Charges (APC)

Academic applies for APC funding

- Complete an online form
- Before article is submitted for publishing

Academic records information in Pure

- Create a publication record in Pure
- Link the record to the relevant RCUK grant

Library approves the APC funding

- Check journal's compliance with RCUK policy
- Check that APC funds are available

Publisher sends the invoice for APC

- Invoice might be processed via JISC OAK

Article is published via gold OA

- Academic updates publication record in Pure
- Library checks the publication on publisher's site

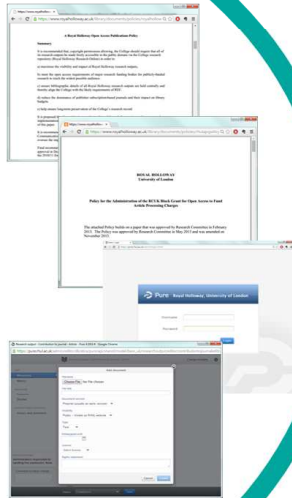
